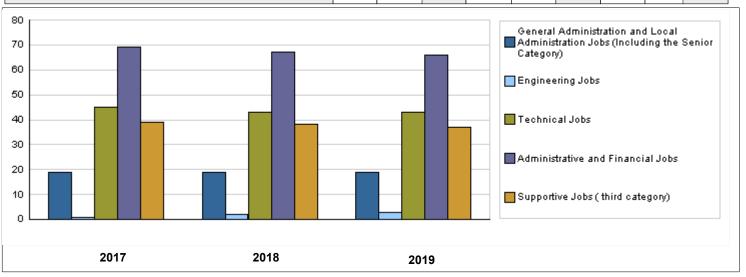
Major Issues and Challenges which face the Ministry / Department:

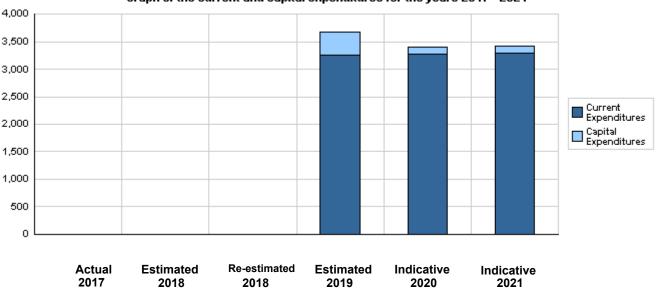

Graph of the current and capital expenditures for the years 2017 - 2021

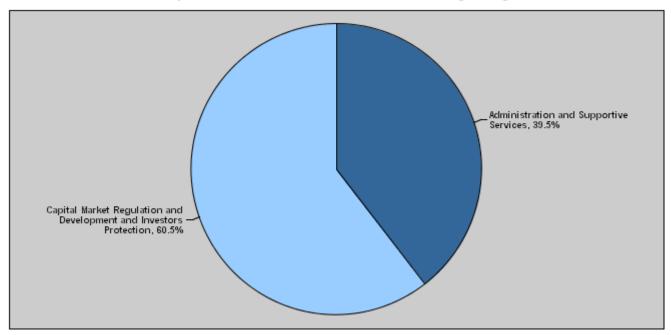
