Chapter: 1110 Judiciary Council

Creation:

- The history of the judiciary in Jordan date back to the early years of establishment of the Amirate of Transjordan, it's one of the three authorities of the State of Jordan aimed at achieving justice, and protection of the rights and freedoms through ensuring application of the principle of the rule of law.
- According to the Constitution of Jordan, the Judicial authority shall be exercised by the courts in their varying types and degrees, and all judgements shall be given in accordance with the law and pronounced in the name of His Majesty the King.
- Judges are independent, and in the exercise of their judicial functions they are subject to no authority other than that of the law. The Judicial Council of Jordan, which represents the top of this authority hierarchy, assume all Judges affairs.

Vision: An independent judicial authority that safeguards justice, and ensures the rights and freedoms.

Mission: Judicial authority achieves justice, with its pillar the Rule of Law and contributes to providing appropriate judicial environment and integration with partners to support the reform and

comprehensive development efforts.

Legal Framework: Independence of the Judiciary Law No.(29) for the year 2014 and amendments thereto and regulations made thereunder, and Judicial Institute's Bylaw No. (49) of 2020.

Tasks of the Ministry / Department:

- _ Develop the works of the judiciary to achieve full justice and good applying the rule of law principle.
- _ Give opinion on the legislations related to the judiciary and submitting suggestions thereon.
- _ Endorse the annual report on the status and progress work of courts
- Consider judges affairs, their appointment, promotion, discipline, transfer, assignment secondment and termination in accordance with the provisions of the law.

Ministry/Department Contribution to the Achievement of the National Objectives:

 Consolidate the State of law, achieve full justice and promote the principles of equal opportunity, transparency and protection of rights and freedoms.

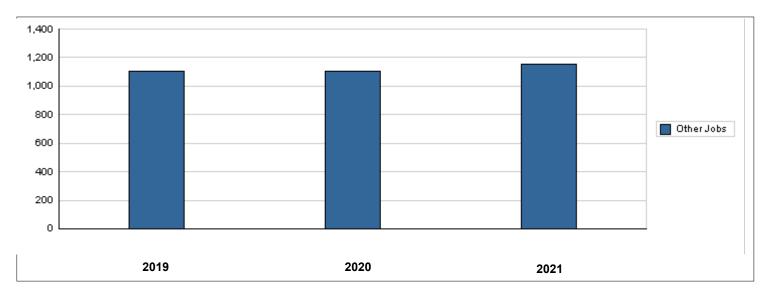
Major Issues and Challenges which face the Ministry / Department:

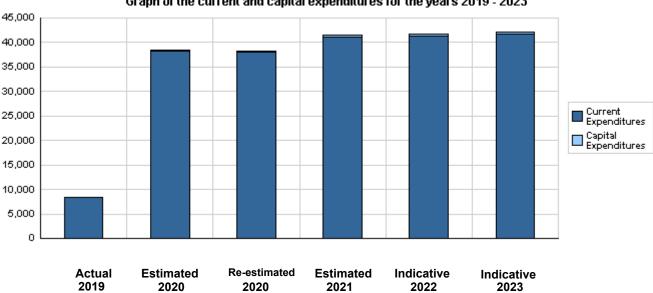

Graph of the current and capital expenditures for the years 2019 - 2023

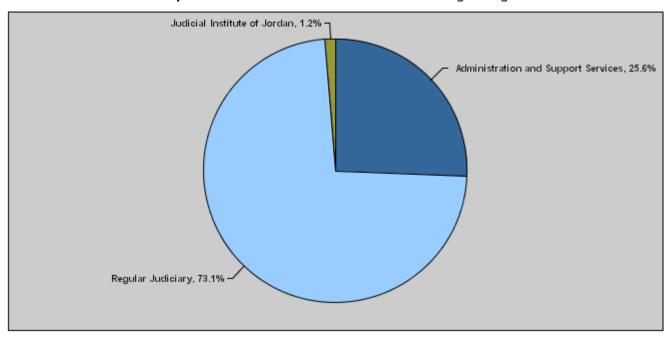
