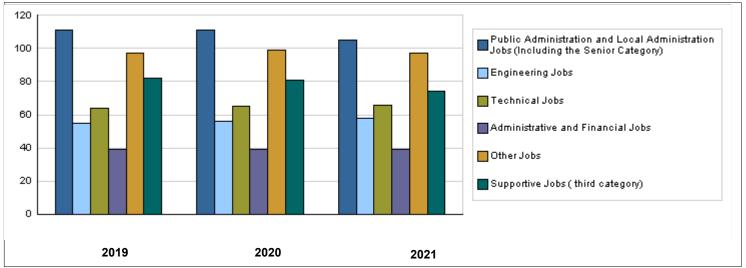

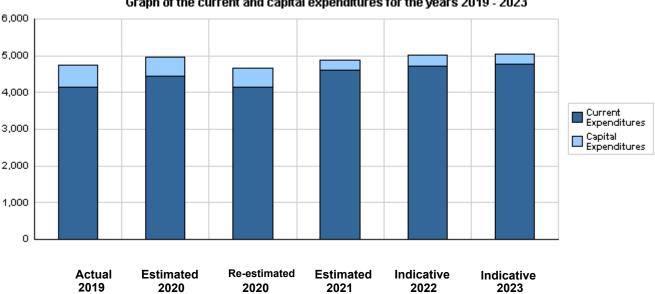

#### Graph of the current and capital expenditures for the years 2019 - 2023

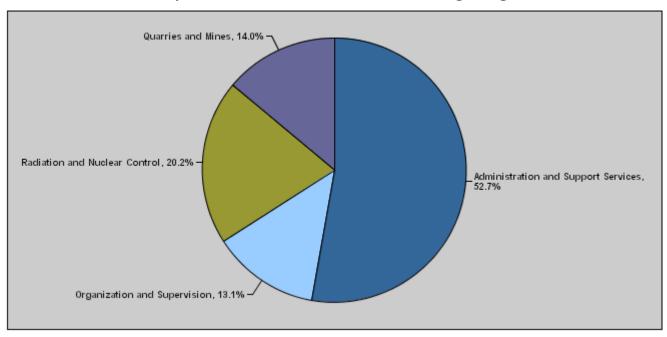
