#### **Chapter: 1110 Judiciary Council**

Creation:

- The judicial authority is originated in Jordan at the first years of establishing the Emirate of Transjordan, which is one of the three authorities in the state working on realizing the full justice and protecting rights and duties through ensuring the application of rule of law principle.

The Jordanian Constitution stipulates that the judicial authority shall be assumed by the courts of all types and degrees and to make judgements as per law in the name of His Majesty the King.
 Judges are independent and no authority over them in their judgements. The Jordanian Judicial

Council which represents the top of this authority assumes all their affairs.

Vision: An independent judicial authority that safeguards justice, and ensures the rights and freedoms.

Mission: Judicial authority achieves justice, with its pillar the Rule of Law and contributes to providing

appropriate judicial environment and integration with partners to support the reform and

comprehensive development efforts.

Legal Framework: Independence of the Judiciary Law No.(29) for the year 2014 and amendments thereto and regulations made thereunder, and Judicial Institute's Bylaw No. (49) of 2020.

### Tasks of the Ministry / Department:

\_ Develop the works of the judiciary to achieve full justice and good applying the rule of law principle.

- \_ Give opinion on the legislations related to the judiciary and submitting suggestions thereon.
- \_ Endorse the annual report on the status and progress work of courts
- Consider judges affairs, their appointment, promotion, discipline, transfer, assignment secondment and termination in accordance with the provisions of the law.

Consolidate the State of law, achieve full justice and promote the principles of equal opportunity, transparency and protection of rights and freedoms.

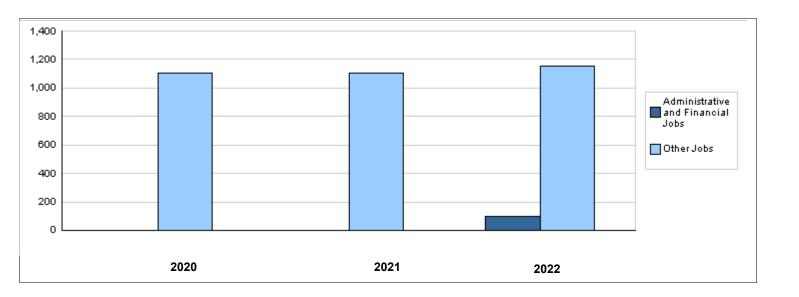

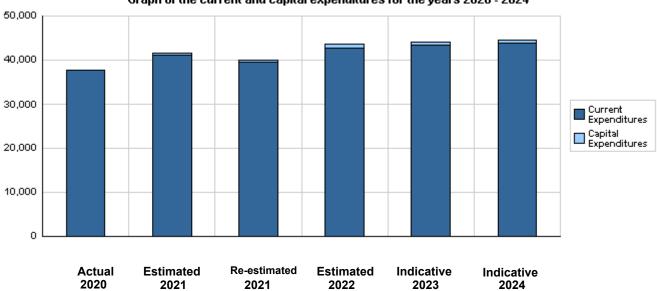

# Graph of the current and capital expenditures for the years 2020 - 2024

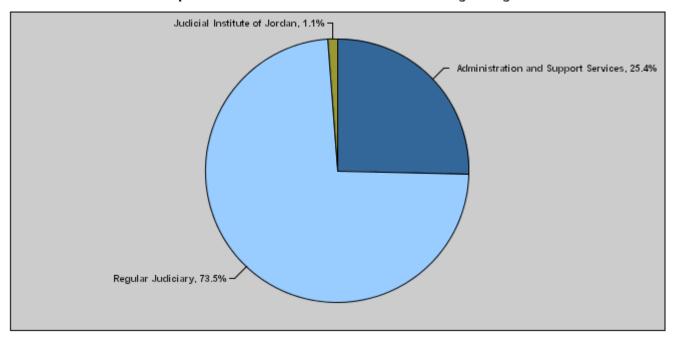
