	the Cooperative Institute, and the establishment of the Cooperative Bank). Jordan Cooperative
	organization continued from 1968 to 1997 during which the Cooperative Bank was established. The
	Cooperative Bank provided loans, trading service, and production requirements. In addition,
	fattening and mechanisms stations and pastoral reserves were established etc. and many

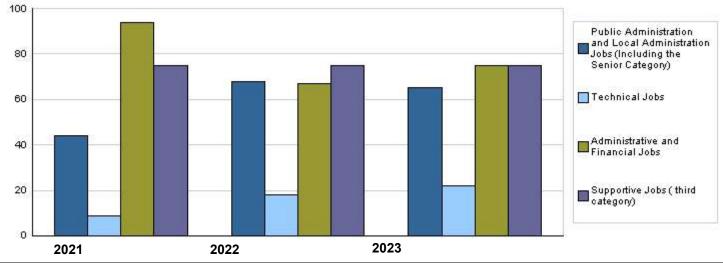

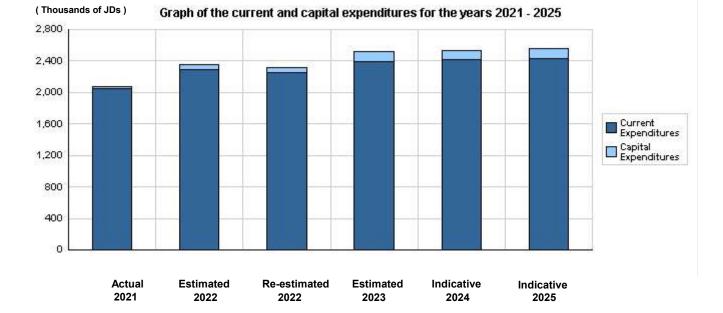
