- Conduct environmental research and studies and issue publications relevant to the environment.
- Formation of one or more environmental committee provided that its/their tasks, way of meetings and decision making should be determined by in its/ their decision of formation
- _ Propose draft laws, bylaws and issue the necessary environmental instructions.
- Prepare management plans for emergency and environmental disasters caused by nature or human.
- Collect, classify and save the environmental information, establish an information system, establish and manage a national environmental database and identify the bases of documentation, circulation, use and provide to those involved.
- Protection of water sources from pollution in the second and third water protection zones specified in the Ministry of Water and Irrigation's Water Sources Protection Instruction
- Placement of the Cabinet with the National Natural Reserve Network and its borders and adoption of the technical and financial mechanisms and tools necessary to implement and operationalize them and reduce their negative impact.

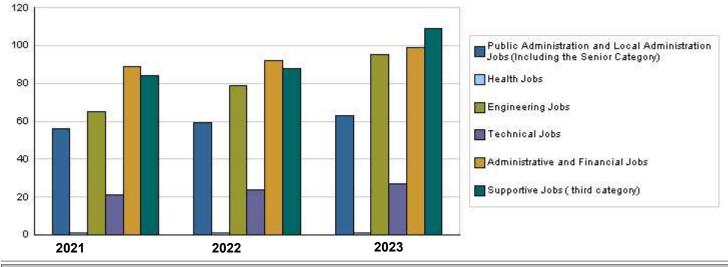

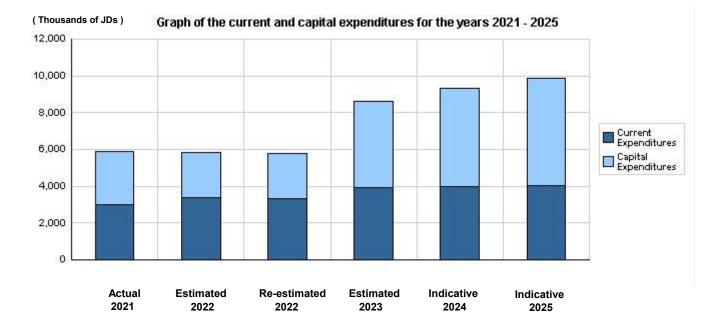
Most notable differences between estimated appropriations for 2023 and re-estimated for 2022

- The increase in operational expenditure by (20) thousand JDs, concentrated in rents and cleaning contracts items
- Other expenditures increased by (11) thousand JDs and this increase was a result of the increase in contributions item

Capital expenditure :

Capital expenditure allocations increased by approximately (2.198) million JDs due to higher allocations of decentralization projects by (477) thousand JDs and the increase in the appropriations of ongoing projects, most notably the environmental services project by (310) thousand JDs and the project for studying the concentrations of pollutants in the air caused by factories by approximately (120) thousand JDs and the project for establishing an electronic system to monitor the concentrations of contaminants by about (116) thousand JDs and allocation for the new project appropriations (development of waste recycling) by (1) million JDs.
