Establishment: The Jordan Center for Disease Control was established as per regulation no.(112) for the year 2020, as it has a legal personality with a financial and administrative independence and by this feature it performs all necessary legal behaviours to reach its objectives including the ownership of movable and immovable property, concluding contracts, acceptance of grants, donations and wills and it may be represented in the related legal and judicial procedures by the civil public defender.

"Excellence and innovation in the fields of public health fields in terms of monitoring, prevention, research, evaluation and policy direction"

Mission:

" The Jordan Center for Disease Control leads and coordinates the national efforts to prevent and fight diseases and face public health challenges through partnership with relevant entities to strengthen Jordan's capacity to combat disease, promote health security, monitor and respond to diseases, and promote evidence-based policies and decisions"

- \_ Coordinate and cooperate with the similar authorities regionally and internationally
- Perform the scientific research, provide and analyze health information
- Building the capacity of the Centre's cadres, qualifying and training them and training personnel in combating epidemics and communicable diseases and rehabilitating them through the provision of professional and academic programmes in cooperation and coordination with relevant agencies locally, regionally and internationally.
- Management of prevention programmes for epidemics and communicable diseases.
- Set out response and readiness plans of health emergency

Ministry/Department Contribution to the Achievement of the National Objectives:

- Strengthening public health practices in the prevention and preparedness of epidemics and communicable diseases, including terrorist biological threats
- Promote accurate health and environmental behaviours and the Kingdom's potentials in health monitoring
- Develop health information systems
- \_ Taking the necessary measures to prevent the dissemination of epidemics and communicable diseases

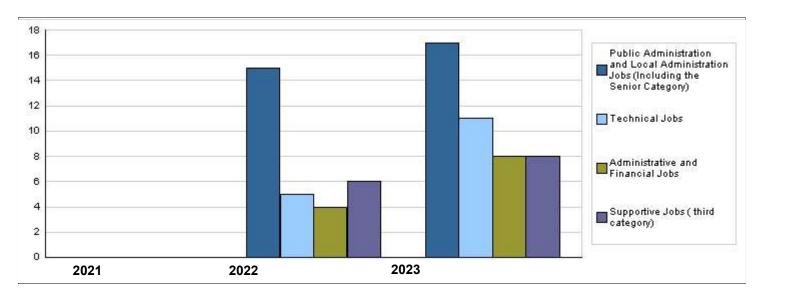
Major Issues and Challenges which face the Ministry / Department :

- As a new entity in a traditional health system, the Centre may face some challenges and obstacles (such as access to monitoring data).
- The political instability in the region may lead to shifting focus from general health to response to emergency one again
- Coordination with the Central Laboratory for Public Health and other laboratories can present challenges without a clear authorization and can be difficult to access to a BSL3 laboratory to respond to an epidemic outbreak
- **\_** 33% of Jordan's population is migrant and refugee, including illegal migrants, which may increase the challenges of reaching them and follow their healthy behaviour.

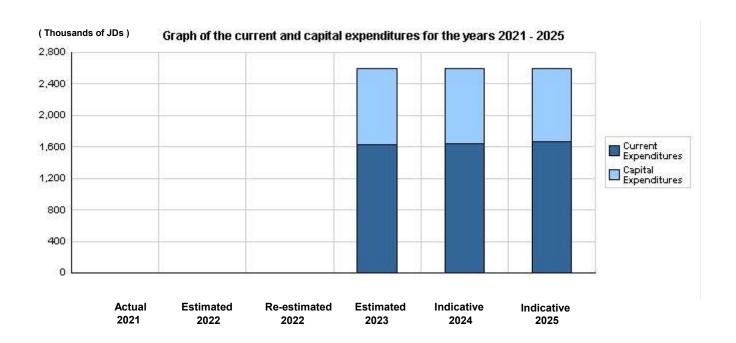
